 - a. Board Priorities
 - i. We have 5 vacancies on the board- our aim is to be intentional and thoughtful about who we add to the board
 - ii. Most of our contacts will likely become (VEEN) members and we should aim for <u>board member</u> nominees that can bring special skills and commitments to join the board. We also hope this would be an opportunity for them to learn and grow personally and professionally from participating on the VEEN board! A mutually beneficial relationship!
 - iii. Priorities Include:
 - Diverse Board Beneficial Skills: (ie science communications, marketing, finance, donor relations,

- social media savvy) any skills that would be helpful in getting our work done!
- 2. Diverse Lived Experience: personal, professional experiences, retired, new in career
- 3. Geographic Diversity: in Vermont, especially representation from NEK, Southern VT
- 4. Non-traditional EE Folks: Doesn't have to be a master naturalist:), could represent different aspects of the field like camp, or outdoor ed, or higher ed, early ed, classroom teachers, or Agency of Ed

 - iv. We may find ourselves in a situation with more applicants than spots so we are designing a rubric of the priorities to keep the decision making process as equitable and unbiased as possible

 - vi. Feedback: Change the title to a **Board Application** instead of 'Nomination' as people feel awkward about nominating them self. We are not really asking others to nominate, we want the individual to step forward and apply even if that takes an invitation or encouragement.
